**Course Title:** Basic Investigator's Course

**Date:** March 22 – March 25, 2010

**Time:** 0800 - 1700

**Course Description:**

This course will provide new investigators with a vast array of knowledge to assist them in the performance of their duties. The majority of this course will be taught by a well renowned instructor in the criminal justice community. Cardinal Criminal Justice Academy is very fortunate to have **Mr. Jon Perry** serve as the lead instructor for this course. A variety of topics will be covered to include:

- Beginning the criminal investigation
- Approaching the crime scene
- Post mortem changes (Chief Medical Examiner)
- Organized v. Disorganized
- Equivocal Death Evaluation
- Deviant Criminal Sexuality
- Drug Investigations
- Behavioral Oriented Interview

The majority of this course will be taught by Mr. Jon Perry, SA, Virginia State Police retired as a Criminal Investigative Analyst for 12 years. Jon started his career with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department retiring after 25 years.

While with the Virginia State Police and the Kansas City, Mo. Police Department, his duties included profiling unknown offenders of violent crime, conducting threat assessments, and providing crisis negotiations, along with instructing homicide investigation, sex crimes investigation and crisis negotiation. Over Jon's career, he has been the primary negotiator in over ninety barricade situations.

Jon received his bachelor's degree from Central Missouri State University in 1973 and his Master's degree from the University of Missouri in 1975. In 1988, Jon spent a one year fellowship at the National Center for the Analysis of Violent Crime, FBI Academy, where he studied "psychological profiling". Jon has instructed at the following institutions: The National Academy, which is housed at the FBI Academy; Ottawa University; Central Missouri State University; Longview Community College; Penn Valley Community College; University of Missouri; Bluefield College and Radford University. In addition, Jon has instructed for the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, the Netherlands National Police, the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in Okinawa, Japan and the New South Wales Police Department in Sydney, Australia.

Jon is a member of the following organizations; Florida Sex Crimes Investigator's Association, the Virginia Negotiator's Association and is currently the President of the International Criminal Investigative Analysis Fellowship, Inc.

Jon has certified as an expert witness four times in the area of Criminal Investigative Analysis and Crisis Negotiation. Two times in Federal Court and two times at the state level, Virginia.

The course will also include blocks of instruction from the Botetourt County Assistant Commonwealth Attorney, the Chief Medical Examiner for Southwest Virginia and several high quality local investigators.
