Course Title: Intermediate Weapons Instructor

Date: April 19 – April 22, 2010

Time: 0700 - 1800

Course Description:

This course will provide the student with a Cardinal Criminal Justice Academy basic instructor endorsement for five types of intermediate weapons:

1. Expandable Baton
2. Riot Baton
3. O.C. Spray
4. Electronic Immobilization Devices
5. Specialty Impact Munitions

The course will provide comprehensive knowledge and skills pertaining to the understanding, deploying and application of intermediate weapons in a law enforcement or correctional environment. This course will also supply the information necessary to design a departmental instruction program for the use of these products.

Enrollment Requirements and Prerequisites:

All prospective students should have a general instructor certification. Students must have no limitations on physical activity.

Course Completion Requirements:

Students must score a 75% on a comprehensive written exam. Students must complete practical exercise testing for each weapon to include being exposed to O.C. spray and an Electronic Immobilization Device.

Students **must** complete a 20 hour internship at Cardinal Criminal Justice Academy.

Required Equipment:

- Expandable baton and scabbard.
- Five (5) rounds of 12 gauge drag stabilized bean bag rounds No. 23DS.
- One (1) round of 40 mm exact impact 1006 foam round No. XM1006.
- Gun belt and handcuffs.
- Agency issued 37mm or 40mm launcher (Academy can provide a launcher if needed)
- Agency issued Stun equipment (Academy can provide EIDs if needed)
- Clothing is standard in-service dress for first day.
- Agency issued chemical protective masks (Academy may provide if needed)

In-Service Credit/Type: 4 hours legal/36 hours career development

Fee: No fee. Course is **NOT** open to non-member agencies. Maximum class size is 18. Training hours are from 0700 – 1800.

Registration: This course is open to member agency personnel only.
