The FBI, Richmond Field Office, will be providing this Regional Crisis Negotiations Course designed for law enforcement officers assigned to negotiate in crisis situations, e.g. barricaded subjects, hostage situations, suicidal subjects, etc.

Applicants will be selected with the understanding that active participation in classroom and training scenarios is a primary requirement. Attendees will be evaluated throughout the week, during the practical application of basic concepts, and at the end of the week, with a written exam.
